




Who is CCD?

Ways of Working


- Platform Setup: Communication platform via Telegram channel facilitated by the Local Coordinator in the Ukrainian language.
- Work Plan: Co-create a detailed plan with members, including workshops and meetings.
- Event Organisation: Host online/offline events and webinars aligned with CSO needs.
- · Cash Working Group (CWG) Collaboration: Participate and feed back to CWG to share collective voices of LNGOs/LCSOs and foster local/global coordination.
- Knowledge Sharing: Share resources, case studies, and newsletters to support learning.
- Networking: Facilitate partnerships between local NGOs and international actors.
- Capacity Strengthening: Provide tailored training and support for CVA implementation.
- Feedback & Advocacy: Gather member insights and develop collective advocacy messages.




Types of Organisations
