- The largest NGO network focused on last-mile delivery of Cash and Voucher Assistance (CVA) in humanitarian settings.
- Dedicated to collaboration aimed at enhancing the impact of cash programming in crisis-affected regions.
- Committed to facilitate evidence-based collaborations that enable impactful, responsive, locally-led, and people-centered design and delivery of CVA.

## Shared Services Hub



In response to the Ukraine regional crisis, CCD has launched a new collaboration model to provide shared technical services to international and local NGOs and support the broader cash ecosystem.

The Ukraine Shared Services Team has a remit to strengthen the capacity of local organisations, ensuring more effective and coordinated CVA delivery to those in need.

## What is a Community of Practice?



A Community of Practice (CoP) is a group that shares knowledge and collaborates on challenges in a specific area, such as humanitarian efforts.

## Local NGO Community of Practice in Ukraine (LNGO CoP)



CCD and Right to Protection (R2P), a leading Ukrainian human rights organisation, established a Local Community of Practice for local NGOs and Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) engaged in CVA programming.

The LNGO CoP provides a safe and inclusive space for discussing CVA, promoting local CSO involvement, and fostering collaboration and capacity strengthening. Its aim is to strengthen local leadership, improve coordination, and support knowledge sharing and advocacy.

## Ways of Working



- **Platform Setup:** Communication platform via Telegram channel facilitated by the Local Coordinator in the Ukrainian language.
- **Work Plan:** Co-create a detailed plan with members, including workshops and meetings.
- **Event Organisation:** Host online/offline events and webinars aligned with CSO needs.
- **Cash Working Group (CWG) Collaboration:** Participate and feed back to CWG to share collective voices of LNGOs/LCSOs and foster local/global coordination.
- **Knowledge Sharing:** Share resources, case studies, and newsletters to support learning.
- **Networking:** Facilitate partnerships between local NGOs and international actors.
- **Capacity Strengthening:** Provide tailored training and support for CVA implementation.
- **Feedback & Advocacy:** Gather member insights and develop collective advocacy messages.

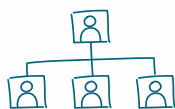


Open to local NGOs engaged in CVA across Ukraine's oblasts, offering a platform for collaborative learning, technical development, and operational improvement.

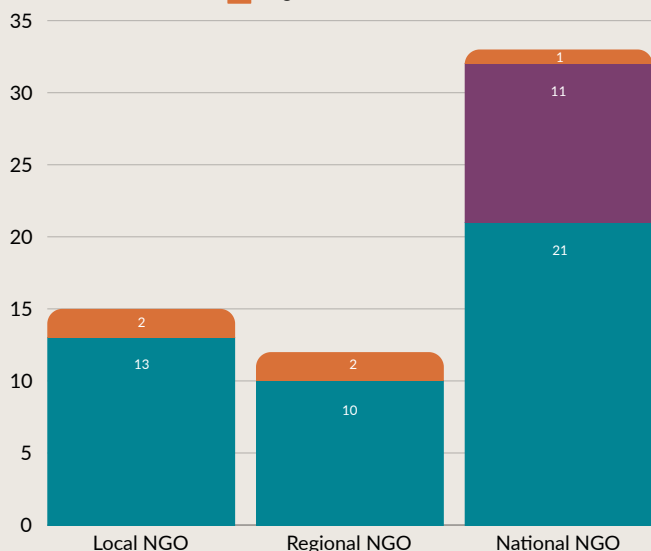
## Cash & Voucher Programs



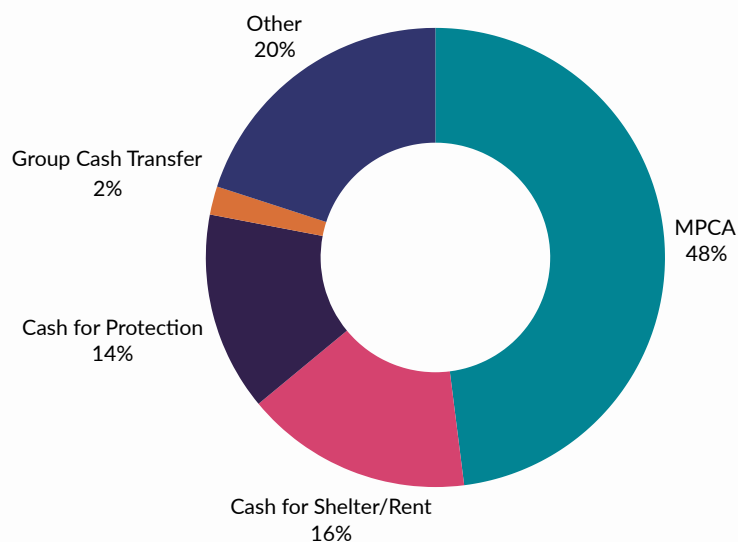
